

Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, April 24, 2019

8:30 a.m.

The Manor Township Traffic Commission met on Wednesday, April 24, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the Manor Township Municipal Building located at 950 West Fairway Drive, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Chairman Mark Harris led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Previous Months Minutes – Chairman Harris made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from the January 30, 2019 meeting as presented, Brandon Clark seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

New Business

Speed Limit Establishment on Kauffman Road – Mark Harris stated that a letter was received from Earla Ament, 3251 Kauffman Road, requesting to prohibit break retarders of trucks. After discussion with Officer Charles Snyder and due to past practice of the Board of Supervisors, this is not a request that can be granted. Ms. Ament also requested the posting of the speed limit on Kauffman Road. A traffic study was completed by Officer Charles Snyder. Officer Snyder's recommendation is to post Kauffman Road at 25 mph.

Brandon Clark motioned to post Kauffman Road at 25 mph, Mark Harris seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Posting of The Speed Limit and a Stop Sign on Bank Barn Lane – Mark Harris commented that approved plans for the subdivision have been received. A traffic study was conducted by Officer Charles Snyder and it is his recommendation to post Bank Barn Lane at 25 mph and a stop sign at the intersection at Bank Barn Lane and Carol Drive which are indicated on the plans.

Brandon Clark motioned to post Bank Barn Lane at 25 mph and a stop sign on Bank Barn Lane, Mark Harris seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

With no further business to discuss, Mark Harris adjourned the meeting at 8:40 a.m.
