

Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, July 31, 2019

8:30 a.m.

The Manor Township Traffic Commission met on Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. in the Manor Township Municipal Building located at 950 West Fairway Drive, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Chairman Mark Harris led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Business From the Floor – Loren Souder of 201 Stone Creek Road, voiced his concern regarding the speed limit and traffic volume on Stone Creek Road. He stated that the traffic has increased, and most vehicles are traveling at a higher rate of speed than the posted 25 mph. He is requesting a traffic study. Chairman Harris recommended doing a study to get the traffic count and speed of the vehicles. Brandon Clark motioned to conduct a traffic study on Stone Creek Road, Chief Graeff seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Old Business – There was none.

New Business

Chairman Harris received a request to establish two handicap parking spots at 9 Colgate Avenue. The request came from resident Gail Smith, who has the appropriate handicap placards for her vehicles. Mr. Harris did respond and let her know that procedure is to grant only one spot. Brandon Clark motioned to grant one handicap parking spot at 9 Colgate Avenue, Chief Graeff seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Harris commented on the two designated parking spots for handicap parking located at the Township's property, 950 West Fairway Drive, that currently have no signage. Chief Graeff motioned to add two handicap parking signs in front of the current painted spots, Brandon Clark seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Chief Graeff mentioned an email he received regarding the parking along both sides of Fairway Drive close to the intersection of Stone Mill Road. The concerned resident stated that cars park along both sides of the street on Fairway Drive making a dangerous situation with cars traveling on Fairway Drive and cars turning from Stone Mill onto Fairway Drive. After discussion from the Board, Ryan Strohecker, Township Manager, stated he would talk with the homeowners at the corner and let them know they need to be parking 30 feet from an intersection.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Harris entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. Chief Graeff so motioned, Brandon Clark seconded, and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:02 a.m.
