

## Manor Township Traffic Commission Minutes

The Manor Township Traffic Commission met on Wednesday, January 25, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. in the Manor Township Municipal Building at 950 West Fairway Drive, Lancaster, PA. Chairman Mark Harris led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

### Re-Organization

Chairman – Brandon Clark nominated Mark Harris as Chairman. Chief Graeff seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Secretary – Mr. Harris nominated Chief Graeff as Secretary. Mr. Clark seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

### Old Business

Mr. Harris reported that Manor Township received a letter from Woods Edge HOA and Chief Graeff responded to their letter in regards to site distance issues at Stone Creek Road and South Centerville Road. The traffic commission was in agreeance with the letter that Chief Graeff sent in response to their request.

### New Business

Mr. Harris said he had received notification from Manor Township resident Ms. Monique Adams addressing her concerns about speeding on Fieldgate Drive. Mr. Harris will email Mrs. Adams to let her know that her concern was addressed at the meeting and inform her of the outcome. Mr. Harris will also let her know that the commission had discussed placing a radar speed sign up this spring in that area to do a speed study.

The Manor Township Police Department questioned the signage on Acorn Lane between Oakridge and Eagle Path. The commission discussed the concern and Mr. Clark made a motion to make the entire west side of Acorn Lane between Oakridge and Eagle Path a no parking zone. Chief Graeff seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

On motion by Mr. Clark and seconded by Chief Graeff, the meeting was adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
