Chairman Mark Harris opened up with allowing discussion from the floor.

Traffic and Speed Concern on Fieldgate Drive

Monique and Jeff Adams, 104 Fieldgate Drive, are concerned with the traffic that travels through their residential area at speeds that exceed the posted 25 miles per hour. The Adams are looking for a solution to help cut down on speed and had a few suggestions including; adding a stop sign, speed bumps and decreasing the speed limit.

Chief Graeff explained the law as to how much over a speed limit someone must be traveling before being able to be pulled over. Chief Graeff also commented that stop signs cannot be installed to control speed and decreasing the speed limit below 25 is not permitted.

Mark Harris commented that speed bumps are not installed in the township due to maintenance issues. In addition, Ryan Strohecker added for insurance issues as well.

Ryan Strohecker commented that this issue has been brought to awareness and additional watches will continue in that area from the police department.
