

Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, June 27, 2018

8:30 a.m.

The Manor Township Traffic Commission met on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. in the Manor Township Municipal Building located at 950 West Fairway Drive, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. Chairman Mark Harris led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Business from the Floor – There was none.

Old Business

Oakridge Drive Study – Speed Limit and Request for the establishment of a Stop Sign on Oakridge Drive at Linville Drive.

Officer Charles Snyder conducted a traffic study at the request of the Manor Township Board of Supervisors.

Chief Graeff stated that based on the information obtained through the traffic study along with the addition of more residential housing, no justification was found to recommend change to the speed limit of 25 mph. Officer Snyder would recommend a stop sign be posted for vehicles entering the roadway from the new housing expansion on Oakridge Drive.

Brandon Clark recommended that a stop sign be posted on Oakridge Drive, Todd Graeff seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Temple Avenue and Millersville Road Study – No Left Turn movement restriction.

Officer Charles Snyder conducted a traffic study at the request of the Manor Township Board of Supervisors. The purpose of the study was to determine the need to change the current posted traffic control devices from the posted No Left Turn to Right Turn Only.

Chief Graeff stated that according to the Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices, it states that a No Left Turn Sign should be placed at the far left corner of the intersection near right corner in conjunction with a Stop Sign. Officer Snyder would recommend the No Left Turn Sign posted on the far right corner be moved to the far left to be in compliance.

Chief Graeff recommended that a No Left Turn Sign be added to the Southwest side of Hawthorn Drive, Brandon Clark seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

New Business

133 Acorn Lane – Parking on a sidewalk – This was discussed by the Board.

With no further business to discuss, Mark Harris entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting, Brandon Clark so motioned, Chief Graeff seconded, and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
