

Manor Township Park & Recreation Minutes

Monday, October 24, 2022

The Manor Township Park and Recreation Commission met on Monday, October 24, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. at the Manor Township Community Park, Hovis Pavilion. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Edward Rand.

Approval of January 24, 2022 Meeting Minutes - Andy Lebo made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Maher Hattar second and motion carried unanimously.

Business from the Floor

Chris Brubaker, 22 Birch Court, invited the members to attend the Land Acknowledgement Program on October 25 at Millersville University which is focusing on Native American history in our area. Ms. Brubaker also commented on an easement from Safe Harbor to the Boy's Club along Creek Road where she would like to see a future pocket park.

New Business

Pickle Ball Court

Public Works Director Mark Harris led a discussion of replacing the current sand volleyball court with three pickle ball courts. Mr. Harris informed the members that the Pickle Ball Court project has been included in the 2023 Public Works budget. Discussion of the members included the use of the land and the appeal of giving more recreation opportunities to senior citizens.

Relocation of the Sand Volleyball Court

Mr. Harris showed the members of a potential location for one sand volleyball court near the basketball court. Discussion followed on the risk of balls going off the court area.

Disc Golf Course Improvements

Mr. Harris informed the members of a recent discussion with members from the Lancaster County Disc Golf Club. The club has proposed changes to the course that may improve the play for all ages.

Moonlight Ride

Township staff is planning a Moonlight ride on November 7 along the Enola Low Grade Rail Trail.

Plaque Presentation

Mr. Harris presented a plaque to the Park and Recreation Board for their financial support of the Safe Harbor Trestle Bridge rehabilitation project.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Edward Rand entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. Courtney Barry so motioned, Dan Fisher seconded, and the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
