

## Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes

### **New Business**

Stop Sign request at Dickinson Avenue and Hemlock Road – Chairman Harris received a note from resident Carolyn Geiger, 1800 Heritage Avenue, requesting an additional Stop Sign be installed at the intersection of Dickinson Avenue and Hemlock Road. Ms. Geiger was involved in an accident at this intersection on August 12, 2022. The other driver failed to stop at the Stop Sign, which resulted in substantial damage to both vehicles. Ms. Geiger is concerned by the increased traffic through the neighborhood as drivers try to avoid traffic lights and congestion on Columbia Avenue. She also reported some sight problems near the intersection. Kimberly Geyer completed an accident study for the past three years. The accident involving Ms. Geiger was the only accident at this intersection. Chairman Harris explained that the intersection is already being controlled by a Stop Sign. He went on to state that the average speed of traffic decreases in areas where on-street parking is permitted. It is unfortunate, but the man who hit Ms. Geiger was at fault because he was unfamiliar with the area and failed to come to a stop.

Chairman Harris made a motion to deny the request to install an additional Stop Sign at the intersection of Dickinson Avenue and Hemlock Road. Kimberly Geyer seconded and the motion carried unanimously.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Harris entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. Missy Phelan so motioned. Kimberly Geyer seconded and the meeting adjourned at 8:45 a.m.
