

## Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes

The Manor Township Traffic Commission met on Wednesday, February 25, 2026 at 8:30 a.m. in the Manor Township Municipal Building located at 950 West Fairway Drive, Lancaster, Pennsylvania. ### **Old Business**

#### **Speed Limit for Witmer Road**

Chief Cleary stated that Officer Snyder completed a comprehensive study on Witmer Road over a period of days and surveyed 749 vehicles. Officer Snyder recommended that it be posted at 35 miles per hour.

Chief Cleary made a motion that the Speed Limit for Witmer Road be posted at 35 miles per hour. Missy Phelan seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

#### **Posting one-way Streets in Manor Ridge**

After discussion of the impacts to the neighborhood, and minimal crash data the Traffic Commission unanimously agreed not to act on the request.

### **New Business**

Chairman Harris entertained a motion to add the discussion point of snow emergency routes to the agenda. Chief Cleary so motioned, Missy Phelan seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Harris inquired to Chief Cleary about the process of designating snow emergency routes. Chief Cleary has experience of the establishment and enforcement of snow emergency routes and will bring back information to the next Traffic Commission meeting. The areas to consider are West Fairway Drive between 741 and Joseph Road, and Cartledge Lane between Knollwood Road and Bradford Lane.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Harris entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. Chief Cleary so motioned and Missy Phelan seconded, the motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
